where he had never been.

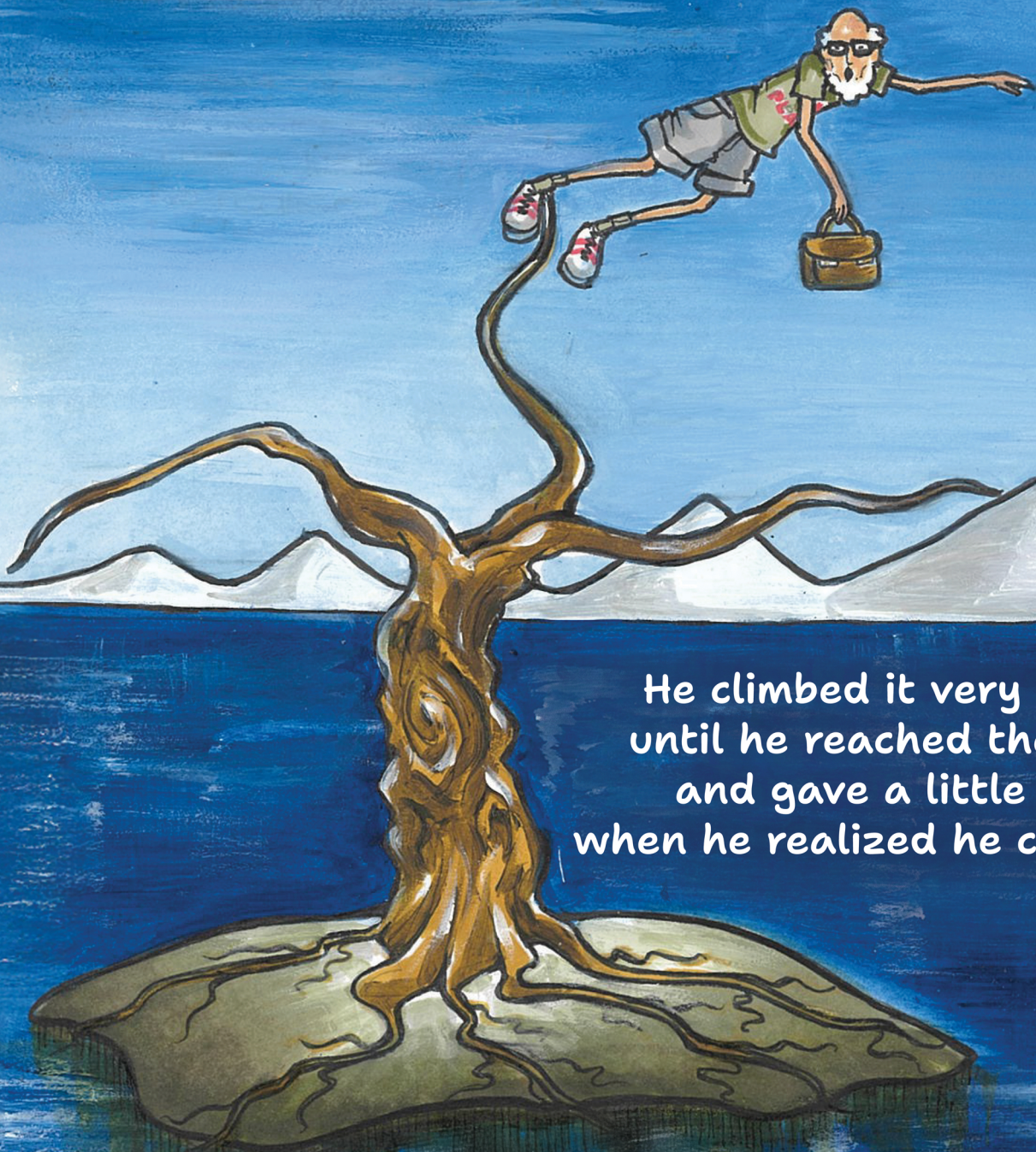


So he packed his case,

So he swam across to see!

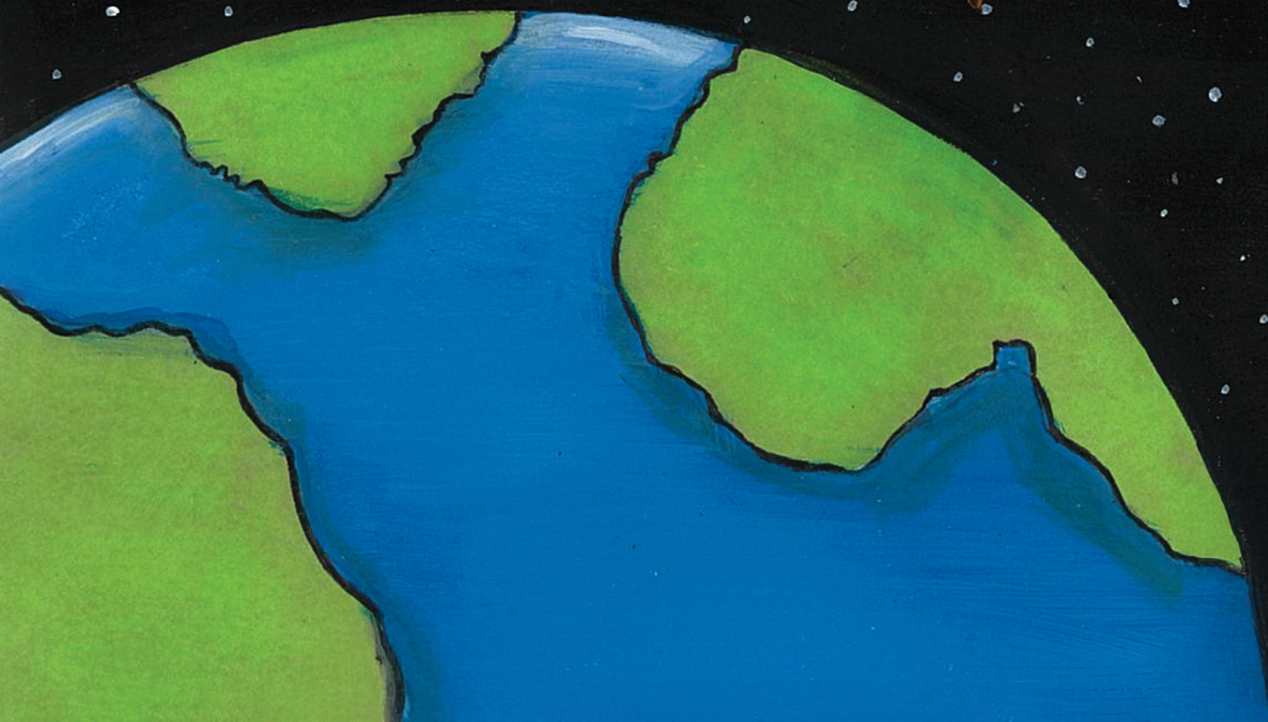


He climbed it very high,
